#### **Scholarship Review Process**

- 1. If your scholarship application packet is received by the deadline, it will be opened and reviewed for completeness by the Chair of the Scholarship Committee.
- 2. If your application is accepted, it will be assigned to at least two members of the Scholarship Committee for evaluation and scoring.
- 3. Applicants will be scored during the interview phase.
- 4. Once the interview phase has been completed, the Scholarship Committee will convene to select the 2020 scholarship recipient.
- 5. Scholarship recipients will be notified within fifteen (15) business days following the decision-making process.
